WARNING ZONE VISIT – Wednesday 11th June 2025

We have organised for Year 6 to visit the Warning Zone in Leicester on Wednesday 11th June.

The Warning Zone is a centre which contains a superb range of facilities and presents the children with a really great opportunity to experience various safety scenarios. The children will learn how to keep themselves and their friends safe and the activities include understanding all about fire safety, road safety, railway safety, building safety, electricity safety, water safety and personal safety. All the group activities and scenarios are led by members of the Emergency Services or retired teachers. In addition, there will be an afternoon session in the E Safety Zone.

The Warning Zone is now based at a newly refurbished centre at Frog Island in Leicester. We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at around 9am, and spending the day at the Centre. We will be back by the end of the school day. Your child will need a packed lunch and plenty to drink. (No glass bottles or fizzy drink please.) Children will need to be in full school uniform.

The Woolden Hill Association have kindly offered to pay for most of the trip we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£5.00 per child** payable on parent pay by the 23rd May 2025. The school has no funds to subsidise this visit, and it can only take place provided that all parents/carers are prepared to make this voluntary contribution to cover the costs, as permitted by the Education Act 1996. Contributions should be paid via Parent Pay by Friday 23rd May 2025. If you receive Pupil Premium funding for your child, the cost of the trip will come from the funding.
